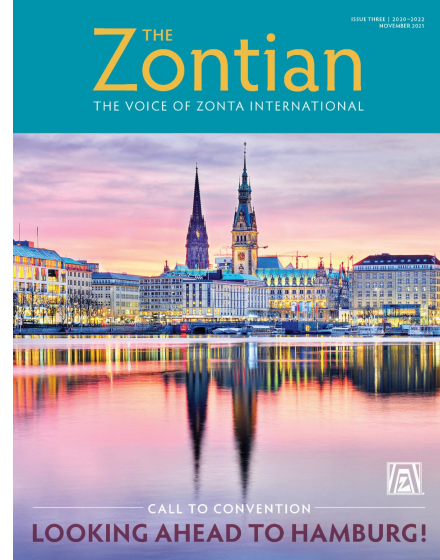

### Zonta Club of Accra Jubilee organizes local health screening

The Zonta Club of Accra Jubilee, Ghana, organized a health screening and sexual reproductive health program on 28 October in the underprivileged community of Chorkor. Chorkor has notably high levels of teenage pregnancy and early marriage. Through this program, the club seeks to transform the outlook for girls by empowering them with education and sexual reproductive health awareness, which will help launch and protect their dreams.



The club plans to have a biennial health screening and sexual reproductive program. For their first year, they reached 113 females, of which 66 were girls.

### Zonta Club of Helsinki III became Santa's little helpers

For many years, the Zonta Club of Helsinki III, Finland, celebrate during this time of year by having a holiday dinner and exchanging presents. However, the members wanted to do something more.



The club partnered with *Helsinki ensikotiyhdistys*, an organization that provides a place for unhoused mothers and children to live after the birth of a child; and prepares gifts and cards for the children. Despite not knowing the children's names due to privacy issues, the club ensures the little ones and their loved ones are thought of and the members are very grateful to be holiday helpers this year.
