Since the Chadwick International School (CIS) Z Club, South Korea, was first established in September 2015, the club has continuously exemplified the Zonta spirit through its service and advocacy.



Recently, the Z club delivered a donation of 4 million Korean won to the Ukrainian Embassy in Seoul.

Lieutenant Governor Unna Huh said that "the Z club has been working for women's rights for nearly seven years, but this Ukraine crisis is a human rights issue, so I joined the group. The students who came to the field today are in their upper [levels], so studying is important. But I think volunteer work is also a big task at our school."
